# FAQS ABOUT AUDITIONS AT LONGY

## HOW TO SIGN UP FOR COMMUNITY PROGRAMS' ENSEMBLE AUDITIONS

**New students to Longy, please go to**  
<http://activenet17.active.com/longyschoolofmusic/>

- Click on "Request New Account". You will only need to create an account the first time you register.
- The account must be created for the parent/guardian's information first (*You will be able to add your child to your account once it has been approved*). Fill in all required information. This information will be replacing what we currently have on file, so please make sure it is complete.
- Once you have submitted your information, the following message will appear on the screen:

*Your request for a new customer account has been successfully received. Login information will be sent to you by email once your request has been approved. Your Login Name and Password will allow you access to the advanced features of this site after you validate your email address by clicking the validation link.*

- Please allow 1 business day for your account to be approved.
- Once your account has been approved you will receive an e-mail with a link to the log-in page. Click on the activation link (the second listed in the e-mail). You will use your approved e-mail and requested password to log-in.
- Once you are logged in, click on "Change Information About Family Members" to add your child to your account.
- To register, click on "Register for Classes".

Auditions are listed as "2011-2012 Ensemble Auditions". As soon as you are registered, the Community Programs Office will contact you to set up an audition time.

## GENERAL AUDITION INFORMATION

- Students wishing to return to the same group or chamber music level **DO NOT** need to re-audition.
- All students pay **ONE** audition fee regardless of how many auditions they take. Current Longy students pay \$15. New students pay \$25.
- An e-mail will be sent to you confirming your audition date and time. This should take about two days after your online application has been processed.
- When you arrive for your audition, please go to the check in table located in the main lobby of Zabriskie House, 27 Garden Street. The attendant will help you find your warm-up and audition rooms.
- Auditions will be held at Longy located at 27 and 33 Garden Street, Cambridge. Room assignments will be listed at the check-in table.
- All auditions are played without an accompanist.
- Some students will need to sight-read. Please review the audition requirements carefully.
- Group warm-up rooms will be available.
- Proper attire is requested for the auditions. Please dress the way you would for a special occasion. Please do not wear sneakers, flip-flops, jeans or t-shirts.
- Most auditions last no longer than 10 minutes and are usually on time. Young Performers Program auditions will take approximately 15–20 minutes.
- Results will be e-mailed to the address on your application, no later than **JUNE 15<sup>th</sup>**.

- a major and minor scale and arpeggio (for piano – triads and /or 4 note chords in addition to arpeggios)
- two contrasting pieces
- one etude
- sight reading
- theory placement exam
- chorus/orchestra placement
- chamber music or a cappella audition (optional)

# ORCHESTRAL PROGRAM

New students do not audition for a specific orchestra but rather for placement in the orchestral program as a whole. Once accepted, students are placed in an orchestra according to their age and skill level. Please use the information below as a general guideline on what a student should prepare for their audition. **Students wishing to return to the same orchestra DO NOT need to audition.**
