# The Classes

Each student will have a daily mini-private lesson and a group lesson, as well as enrichment classes and other activities.

**Mini-Private Lessons** will have three or four students in a class. Students attend an hour of lessons daily, learning both from their own and from the other students' coachings. Students are placed according to their Suzuki book level. Parents are welcome to attend the private lesson period with their child.

## Suzuki Violin, Viola and Cello Group Classes

are Suzuki repertoire classes in which students will work on review pieces in the books leading up to and at the students' individual levels. Students will work on playing and ensemble skills while polishing pieces in preparation for Program group concerts.

**Enrichment Classes and Activities** will include theory, sight-reading, art, drumming, klezmer and more. The schedule of daily activities is dependent on the level of the student and on enrollment.
